Foundation Transition Sessions

Our Foundation Transition program is run over six sessions. Students participate in a range of activities which include meeting Foundation and Specialist teachers and visiting different classrooms throughout the school. In the final session, students are in their 2025 classroom with their 2025 teacher and classmates. We strongly encourage students to attend as many sessions as possible to familiarise themselves with the school, build friendships and their confidence. As teachers, we use these sessions to meet students and help create our 2025 classes. Every Transition session is run for 1 hour on various Friday mornings in Term 4, except the final session which is a half day.
